Covid 19

With the increase in cases of Covid in schools and the requirement to limit the numbers of visitors in schools, we have unfortunately, had to postpone the Friends AGM until after the summer holidays.

If your child tests positive for COVID19 next week, it is important that you notify the school of this we can immediately, so that identify any possible contacts. Please the holidaysupport@thepark.surrey.sch.uk email to let us know. We will not be taking calls to the school office so please do not telephone the school during the holidays. We will only inform you of a positive case during the school holidays if your child has been identified as a contact. You are welcome to use the holiday support email for any messages during August. The Department for Education are asking all secondary schools, including special schools, to have on-site asymptomatic testing at the start of next term. This will involve two tests three to five days apart. We are currently planning how we will do this with the least disruption to learning. As many students have been using the lateral flow tests at home and are familiar with the routines involved, we plan to send out consent forms on the INSET day on the 1st September and then test students in small groups on the first and second day of term followed by a second test the following week. The government may change its guidance across the summer, and we would update you at the start of term. The most important factor is that we have a smooth start to term and the least disruption.
