# Testing at home throughout the Easter holidays for schools and colleges

Following the success of the asymptomatic testing programme on the return to school and college, the Department for Education are asking everyone to keep testing at home throughout the Easter holidays and into the summer term. They have asked staff and students to test twice a week (Sunday & Wednesday) at home from now on (all those who are able to). Following testing you report results online as positive, negative or void. This information is critical in helping Public Health England to understand the prevalence of the virus across the country. Staff and students are asked to continue to test twice weekly (Sunday & Wednesday) over the Easter holidays and test before returning to school or college for the summer term.
