Dear Parents and Carers,

CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID 19 AT THE PARK SCHOOL LETTER TO ALL PARENTS AND CARERS

We have been made aware that a member of staff at The Park School has tested positive for COVID19 at the weekend.

We know that you may find this concerning but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England. This letter is to inform you of the current situation and provide you with some general advice. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

In line with the government guidance, students in Year 7, 8 and 9 must stay at home and move to remote learning from tomorrow Monday 23rd November returning to school on Monday 7th December.

Students in Y10 and Y11 are expected to be in school as normal.

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they must not come to school and should remain at home for at least **10 days** from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via <u>https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test or by calling 119</u>. All other household members who remain well, must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days. This includes anyone in your 'Support Bubble'.

The 14-day period starts from the day when the first person in the house became ill.

Household members should not go to work, school or public areas and exercise should be taken within the home. Household members staying at home for 14 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection the household could pass on to others in the community
