Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a really successful return to school for all students since the lockdown ended in March. In the Autumn term the average engagement scores from the logbooks for the whole school was 51. The average logbook scores are currently 55 for the whole school which shows how well students are learning. We have a few updates for you below:

### Early closure Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June

After the governments announcements this week I would just like to confirm that Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June will be an early closure at 1.30pm for Y7 to Y10 as that is the Y11 Record of Achievement afternoon.

### Face coverings

From Monday students will not need to wear face coverings in school. The government guidance says 'From 17 May, in line with Step 3 of the roadmap, face coverings will no longer be recommended for pupils in classrooms or communal areas in all schools. Face coverings will also no longer be recommended for staff in classrooms. In all schools we continue to recommend that face coverings should be worn by staff and visitors in situations outside of classrooms where social distancing is not possible (for example, when moving around in corridors and communal areas).'

### Covid-19 Lateral Flow Tests

We are still awaiting delivery of more Covid-19 Lateral Flow Tests, as soon as they arrive in school we will distribute to students.

We are restarting Friends at The Park (our PTA) after all the lockdowns and have an informal meeting and cup of tea on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> May at 2.30pm for anyone interested in joining. Please let the office know if you would like to attend.

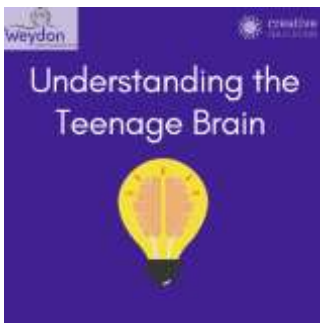
### End of term
