As a part of your child's education at The Park we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive PSHE curriculum. The Department for Education announced changes to relationships and sex education (RSE), which is part of our program of study. These changes came into effect from September 2020 and all schools are required to comply with the updated requirements.

- Physical and emotional maturity
- Religious and cultural backgrounds
- Special educational needs and disabilities

PSHE is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body. All teaching takes place in a safe learning environment and is underpinned by our school ethos and values.
