

Dear Parents / Carers,

We have completed our second full week of a new term. All our students have settled in well. Here are some updates about the term and year ahead.

### Covid measures in place

- 1. We are ensuring good hygiene for everyone. This includes hand hygiene with frequent hand washing for all students and staff.
- 2. We are reminding students about respiratory hygiene and that 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach continues to be very important.
- 3. We are maintaining a high standard of cleaning regimes. We have a thorough cleaning schedule in place to ensure that frequently touched surfaces are kept clean.
- 4. We are keeping occupied spaces well ventilated to ensure good airflow.
- 5. We are following public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19.
- 6. We are keeping our assemblies small with only two year groups meeting in the hall for assembly. This allows us to provide good spacing between students. Ethan would be doing an assembly with Y10/11 with chairs arranged separately and Y10 and 11 sat on separate sides.
- 7. We also continue to carefully manage the number of visitors in school.
- 8. We continue to have two sittings at lunch to reduce numbers in the hall and café.

Schools are required to monitor testing at home so when students complete a home test, we would ask you to complete the form in the Covid 19 section of our website.
