On Tuesday 18th July, Year 10 students will be visiting the New Forest Animal Park and Moor Valley Country Park as part of Activities Week. We will spend the day walking amongst the wildlife and enjoying the play trail at the country park. On the journey home we will be stopping off at Fleet Services.

We will be leaving from school straight after registration and will return to school at 6.00pm where students will be collected by their parents / carers.

Please can students wear suitable outdoor clothing and bring a coat in case it rains. If your child uses an inhaler, please ensure they have this with them on the day.

Students will need to come in with a packed lunch, snacks and water (they may bring or buy fizzy drinks but please no energy drinks). A packed lunch will be provided for students in receipt of Free School Meals.

If students would like to buy souvenirs from the Wildlife Park or food at Fleet Services, we are happy for them to do so and we suggest a maximum of £15 spending money.

The cost of the trip is £13.00, please make payment via the Arbor Parent Portal which can be accessed via the following link: login.arbor.sc. **The Park School is a cashless site - cash payments will not be accepted.**
