#### Coronavirus - School update

As expected, the Prime Minister has recently made announcements about the further easing of lockdown measures in England, with the relaxation of the 2-metre social distancing rules and changes in advice to anyone shielding etc. At this point, these changes have not affected anything currently in place at school and we continue to implement the strict Department for Education (DfE) guidance on safety and hygiene.

Gavin Williamson, the Education Secretary also announced last week that all pupils in all year groups in England will go back to school full-time in September and over the coming weeks the DfE will publish further information and guidance to help schools prepare for a full return. We are therefore working on the assumption that The Park School will be open to all pupils from the start of the autumn term. We fully expect there to be restrictions or additional safety measures in some form and as the DfE announces these, we will keep you informed.

If you are still planning to take an overseas holiday over the summer break, please be mindful of the current government guidance around quarantining for 14 days on your return. If this guidance remains during the summer holidays and you are going overseas at the end of the 6-week break this will delay your child's return to school. If this affects your child, please can you contact the school office so that we can update our information.

#### **Year 11 Record of Achievement**

On the last two Fridays we have held Record of Achievement events for our Y11 students. With half the year group at a time we were able to present each student with their Record of Achievement and mark the end of their time at The Park. We also presented our Y11 Trophies, with Nicolas Matias being awarded Student of the Year. It was wonderful to see so many Y11s able to come back to see each other and celebrate their time at school.
