Provision for all students at The Park

As part of student personalised learning we may also provide a wide range of interventions to support those who are making slower than expected progress in a particular area of learning or who need to have their learning extended as they are making faster than expected progress. This could include; additional literacy support by teaching assistants or English specialists or additional maths support within lesson.
